The NCLEX-RN Training Program is a **no cost** nurse licensing exam preparation course for **internationally trained nurses**.

This program can help you:

- Improve your English language skills
- Practice nursing skills
- Prepare for the NCLEX-RN examination to become re-licensed in New York State

Eligibility requirements:

- Be 18 years or older
- Have high-intermediate level of spoken English
- Be an English Language Learner
- Be a New York City resident and legally authorized to work in the United States
- Have a nursing degree from a country other than the United States
- Be available to study a minimum of 16 hours per week in the evenings for 8 months
- Submit nurse license verification application to CGFNS and NYSED
- Have reliable internet and a working computer to use during the training program
