### D. ARTICULATION AGREEMENT FOLLOW-UP PROCEDURES

1. *Procedures for reviewing, updating, modifying or terminating agreement:*  
 The Academic (Program) Director and/or Department Chair from both programs will review the agreement every two years. Modification or termination of this agreement requires the approval of both Chief Academic Officers of both institutions. LaGCC shall honor the terms granted to students who have already transferred into the A.A. in Liberal Arts - Early Childhood Option should this agreement be modified or terminated. Both the CUNY School of Professional Studies and LaGuardia Community College value this agreement and see it as a “win” for our students.
2. *Procedures for evaluating agreement, i.e., tracking the number of students who transfer under the articulation agreement and their success:*  
 The CUNY School of Professional Studies and LaGuardia Community College will review student retention, progress to graduation including transitions between prerequisite and follow-on courses, degree completion, and GPA. The CUNY Institutional Research Database will be used to track all transfer students, including their performance (credit accumulation and GPA) and persistence (retention and graduation).

3. *Sending and receiving college procedures for publicizing agreement, e.g., college catalogs, transfer advisers, Websites, etc.:*

The CUNY School of Professional Studies and LaGuardia Community College will publicize this articulation agreement on their respective websites and publications (i.e. annual bulletins, course catalogs, program marketing materials, etc.). Transfer advisors at SPS will promote this agreement with eligible students.
