### **Reporting Positive Cases**

All individuals who have tested positive for COVID-19 or have any symptoms of Coronavirus should stay home, self-isolate, and immediately notify the College Coronavirus Designees using the applicable email. ### **Registration Holds**

Fall registration opens Monday, April 25. Per a recent change in CUNY policy “Negative Service Indicators”, or “Holds”, will not be placed automatically on students that have not completed vaccine verification. Rather, as in prior semesters, all students will be permitted to register while we continue to communicate to those that still need to complete their verification. Those that fail to comply will have their on-campus and hybrid courses canceled before the start of the semester.

This is unchanged: Students that do not complete vaccine verification will not be permitted to attend on-campus classes (unless they have an approved religious exemption or medical exception).

### **LaGuardia Recommends Mask-Wearing**

At a recent Labor-Management meeting chapter members suggested that LaGuardia take an assertive position on the importance of mask-wearing on campus. I think this is correct. Though the CUNY-wide mask mandate ended in March, we must ensure that LaGuardia remains a mask-friendly environment. Faculty are free to discuss mask-wearing with their students, but they cannot require it. Bottom line: *LaGuardia recommends mask-wearing*. We will post signs reaffirming this important health and safety precaution in the coming days. And, remember: free face masks are available at Public Safety posts at building entrances.
